The programme takes four semesters of coursework plus a fifth semester of Master Thesis research and writing. Teaching days in Semesters 1 and 2 are on Friday, Saturday and Sunday. Teaching days in Semesters 3 and 4 are on Saturday, Sunday and Monday. The programme starts in mid-September.
